TERRORISMThe Prevention of Terrorism (Supplemental Temporary
Provisions) (Amendment) Order 1980

Made - - - - - 3rd September 1980
Laid before Parliament 11th September 1980
Coming into Operation 27th October 1980

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by sections 13 and 14(5) and (6) of and paragraph 1(6)(a), (7) and (8) of Schedule 3 to the Prevention of Terrorism (Temporary Provisions) Act 1976(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Prevention of Terrorism (Supplemental Temporary Provisions) (Amendment) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 27th October 1980.
2. In this Order “the principal Order” means the Prevention of Terrorism (Supplemental Temporary Provisions) Order 1976(b).
3. For Schedule 1 to the principal Order(b) (list of designated ports), there shall be substituted the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Order.
4. The Prevention of Terrorism (Supplemental Temporary Provisions) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1977(c) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order substitutes a new Schedule for Schedule 1 to the Prevention of Terrorism (Supplemental Temporary Provisions) Order 1976, which lists the ports which are designated for the purposes of Article 12 of that Order. That Article requires the approval of an examining officer to the use of ports in Great Britain, other than designated ports, by ships and aircraft travelling between Great Britain, Northern Ireland, the Republic of Ireland or any of the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man. The new list of ports contains changes of nomenclature. Otherwise, the only changes are that Pembroke Dock is added to the list of seaports and hoverports and Hull (Leconsfield) is omitted from the list of airports.
