In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 8 of the Suppression of Terrorism Act 1978(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Suppression of Terrorism Act 1978 (Designation of Countries) (No. 2) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 12th October 1980.
- 2. Iceland is hereby designated as a party to the European Convention on the Suppression of Terrorism signed at Strasbourg on 27th January 1977.
