The Sutton District Water Order 1980

Coming into Operation

29th October 1980

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

- 1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Sutton District Water Order 1980 Citation and and shall come into operation on 29th October 1980.
- (2) The Sutton District Water Acts and Orders 1871 to 1977 and this order may be cited together as the Sutton District Water Acts and Orders 1871 to 1980.
 - 2. In this order, unless the context otherwise requires—

Interpretation.

"the Company" means the Sutton District Water Company;

"the Third Schedule" means the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945;

"the undertaking" means the undertaking of the Company as for the time being authorised by any enactment.

- 3. For the purposes of this order the provisions of the Third Schedule Application which are specified in column (1) of Schedule 1 to this order shall, subject of certain to the modifications set out in column (2) thereof, apply to the under-of taking and are hereby incorporated with this order.

 Schedule.
- 4.—(1) The Company may, when they have obtained sufficient rights or Construction interests in the land described in Part I, II, III, IV or V, as the case may and be, of Schedule 2 to this order—

of Schedule 2 to this order—

(a) continue and maintain the existing borehole constructed on or under that land and construct or continue and maintain on or

- under that land a pumping station and pumping plant for the purpose of abstracting water from such borehole; and

 (b) construct and maintain on or under that land, in addition to the works authorised by section 4 of the Third Schedule as applied to the undertaking by this order, all such additional wells, boreholes, adits and headings as may be percessary or expedient for suggesting.
- works authorised by section 4 of the Third Schedule as applied to the undertaking by this order, all such additional wells, boreholes, adits and headings as may be necessary or expedient for augmenting, improving or maintaining the supply of water obtainable by means of the said existing borehole.
- (2) The works authorised by this order shall for all purposes form part of the undertaking.
