## TRIBUNALS AND INQUIRIES

**The Fees for Inquiries (Variation) (Amendment) Order 1980***Made* - - - - 24th October 1980*Laid before Parliament* 3rd November 1980*Coming into Operation* 28th November 1980

The Minister for the Civil Service, in exercise of powers conferred by section 5 of, and paragraph 6 of Schedule 3 to, the Public Expenditure and Receipts Act 1968(a) and now vested in her(b), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Fees for Inquiries (Variation) (Amendment) Order 1980, and shall come into operation on 28th November 1980.

2. The Schedule to the Fees for Inquiries (Variation) Order 1968(c) shall be amended in the second line of column 3 thereof by substituting for the sum of “£70” the sum of “£105”.

This Order, which amends the Fees for Inquiries (Variation) Order 1968, increases from £70 to £105 the maximum fee payable per day which a Minister may determine under section 250(4) of the Local Government Act 1972 for the services of an officer engaged in an inquiry held under that section.
