## The South West Water Authority (Milton Brook Reservoir Discharge) Order 1980

Made -

13th November 1980

Coming into Operation

21st November 1980

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 1 of the Water Resources Act 1971(a) and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:-

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the South West Water Authority Citation and (Milton Brook Reservoir Discharge) Order 1980, and shall come into commenceoperation on 21st November 1980.

(2) This order shall be included among the enactments which may Interpretabe cited together as the South West Water Authority Orders 1974 to 1980.

2. The South West Water Authority may for the purposes of restoring Authority to and maintaining the level of the Milton Brook Reservoir at a discharge point at National Grid Reference SX 48436497 discharge water at a rate not exceeding the rate of 148,000 cubic metres per day of 24 hours.
