LEGAL AID AND ADVICE, SCOTLAND

The Legal Advice and Assistance (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1980

Made -20th November 1980 Laid before Parliament 27th November 1980 Coming into Operation 1st December 1980

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 4 of the Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1967(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf and with the concurrence of the Treasury, I hereby make the following regulations:-

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Legal Advice and Assistance (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1980 and shall come into operation on 1st December 1980.
- 2. For sub-paragraphs (i) and (ii) of paragraph 8(b) of the Schedule to the Legal Advice and Assistance (Scotland) Regulations 1973(b) there shall be substituted:-
 - "(i) in the case of a spouse at a rate equivalent to 50 per cent above the amount specified for the time being in column (3) of paragraph 6 of Part IV of Schedule 4 to the Social Security Act 1975 (increase for adult dependant of category A retirement pensioner)(c);
 - (ii) in the case of a dependent child or a dependent relative, at a rate equivalent to 50 per cent above the amount specified for the time being in paragraph 3 of Schedule 1 to the Supplementary Benefit (Requirements) Regulations 1980(d) appropriate to the age of the child or relative.
