**The Greater Manchester
(Local Statutory Provisions) Order 1980**

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 262(9)(b) of the Local Government Act 1972(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Greater Manchester (Local Statutory Provisions) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 31st December 1980.
2. The date on which all the local statutory provisions applying to the whole or part of the county of Greater Manchester, so far as they so apply, are to cease to have effect, is hereby postponed to 30th June 1981.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

Section 262(9) of the Local Government Act 1972 provides that all local statutory provisions are to cease to have effect in metropolitan counties at the end of 1979. That date was postponed to 31st December 1980 in respect of provisions applicable to a metropolitan county by the Metropolitan Counties (Local Statutory Provisions) Order 1979 (S.I. 1979/969), and it is further postponed to 30th June 1981 in respect of provisions applying to Greater Manchester by the present order.
