**1980 No. 1900****NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE ENGLAND AND WALES****The National Health Service (Vocational Training) Amendment  
Regulations 1980**

The Secretary of State for Social Services, in exercise of powers conferred upon him by section 32 of the National Health Service Act 1977<sup>(a)</sup> and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. These regulations may be cited as the National Health Service (Vocational Training) Amendment Regulations 1980 and shall come into operation on 8th January 1981.

*Amendment to regulations*

2. In regulation 5(5)(a)(i) of the National Health Service (Vocational Training) Regulations 1979 <sup>(b)</sup> for the words “the day on which these regulations are made” there shall be substituted the words “the 10th December 1980”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These regulations amend the National Health Service (Vocational Training) Regulations 1979 by substituting a later date for that immediately before which a post may be approved so as to count as an "educationally approved post" for the purposes of regulation 5 of those regulations which relates to certificates of prescribed experience for the purposes of sections 30 to 32 of the National Health Service Act 1977.
