TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT

The Employment Act 1980 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1980

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 21 of the Employment Act 1980(a) hereby makes the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Employment Act 1980 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1980.
- 2. Section 19(a) of the Employment Act 1980 and section 20(3) of that Act as far as it relates to the repeals of section 1A of the Trade Union and Labour Relations Act 1974(b) and section 2 of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Amendment) Act 1976(c) shall come into operation on 22nd December 1980.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings into operation on 22nd December 1980 the remaining provisions of the Employment Act 1980 which are not already in operation. The effect of the Order is to bring into operation the repeals of the sections of the Trade Union and Labour Relations Act 1974 and the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Amendment) Act 1976 which provide for the preparation of a charter relating to the freedom of the press.
