## EXPORT GUARANTEES

**The Export Guarantees (Extension of Period) (No. 2) Order 1980***Laid before the House of Commons in draft**Made - - - - - 10th March 1980**Coming into Operation 11th March 1980*

Whereas a draft of this Order has been laid before the House of Commons and has been approved by resolution of that House in accordance with section 13 of the Export Guarantees and Overseas Investment Act 1978(a) (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"):

Now therefore the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under section 5(4) of the Act hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Export Guarantees (Extension of Period) (No. 2) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on the day after it is made.

2. The period during which arrangements may be made by the Secretary of State under section 5 of the Act for making payments to persons carrying on business in the United Kingdom who have entered into export contracts, being payments related to cost increases, which was extended by the Export Guarantees (Extension of Period) Order 1979(b) to 26th March 1980, shall be further extended by one year.
