The Attachment of Earnings (Employer's Deduction) Order 1980

Made - - - 14th April 1980

Laid before Parliament 29th April 1980

Coming into Operation 1st June 1980

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 7(4)(a) and (5) of the Attachment of Earnings Act 1971(a), hereby makes the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Attachment of Earnings (Employer's Deduction) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 1st June 1980.
- 2. On any occasion when, after the coming into operation of this Order, an employer makes a deduction from a debtor's earnings in compliance with an attachment of earnings order, he shall be entitled to deduct, in addition, 50 pence towards his clerical and administrative costs, in lieu of the sum of 13 pence prescribed by the Attachment of Earnings (Employer's Deduction) Order 1975(b), and section 7(4)(a) of the Attachment of Earnings Act 1971 shall have effect accordingly.
- 3. The Attachment of Earnings (Employer's Deduction) Order 1975 is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

The Order increases from 13p to 50p the additional amount which an employer making a deduction from a debtor's earnings under an attachment of earnings order may take towards his administrative and clerical costs.
