OATHS

The Commissioners for Oaths (Fees) Order 1980

Made - - - 21st January 1980
Coming into Operation 11th February 1980

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 216 of the Supreme Court of Judicature (Consolidation) Act 1925(a) and with the concurrence of the Lord Chief Justice and Master of the Rolls, hereby makes the following Order:—

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Commissioners for Oaths (Fees) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 11th February 1980.
- (2) In this Order the expression "commissioner for oaths" includes a solicitor exercising the powers of a commissioner for oaths under section 81 of the Solicitors Act 1974(b).
- 2.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), the following fees shall be charged by commissioners for oaths:—

- (2) Where value added tax is payable by a commissioner for oaths supplying a service for which a fee is prescribed under paragraph (1), he shall charge for that service a fee of such an amount as, with the addition of the tax, is equal to the amount so prescribed.
- 3. The Commissioners for Oaths (Fees) Order 1975(c) is hereby revoked, save as to any fee due or payable before the commencement of this Order.
