TELEGRAPHS

The Wireless Telegraphy (Broadcast Licence Charges and Exemption) (Amendment) Regulations 1980

<i>Made</i> - - - -	11th June 1980
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	20th June 1980
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	31st July 1980

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(1) of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1949(a) as enacted, and also as extended by the Wireless Telegraphy (Channel Islands) Order 1952(b) and the Wireless Telegraphy (Isle of Man) Order 1952(c) and now vested in him(d), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby, with the consent of the Treasury, makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Wireless Telegraphy (Broadcast Licence Charges and Exemption) (Amendment) Regulations 1980 and shall come into operation on 31st July 1980.

2. In these Regulations, “the principal Regulations” means the Wireless Telegraphy (Broadcast Licence Charges and Exemption) Regulations 1970(e).

3. The principal Regulations shall have effect subject to the following amendments, that is to say—

- (a) in Regulation 5, for “one shilling (£0.05)”, there shall be substituted “£1.50”;
- (b) in the third column of Schedule 3, for “5s (£0.25)”, in both places, there shall be substituted “£1.50”; and
- (c) for Schedule 4 there shall be substituted the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Wireless Telegraphy (Broadcast Licence Charges and Exemption) Regulations 1970 by increasing certain fees prescribed by those Regulations. The fee for a duplicate of a television licence which has been lost or destroyed is increased from £0.05 to £1.50 and that for a television licence for apparatus used by a dealer only for demonstration, testing or repair, is increased from £0.25 to £1.50. The Regulations also substitute a new scale of fees for the issue and renewal of licences for broadcast relay apparatus.
