**The Grant-Aided Secondary Schools (Scotland) Grant
Amendment Regulations 1980**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	6th June 1980
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	20th June 1980
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	14th July 1980

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 75(c) and 144(5) of the Education (Scotland) Act 1962(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Grant-Aided Secondary Schools (Scotland) Grant Amendment Regulations 1980 and shall come into operation on 14th July 1980.

Interpretation

2. In these regulations, a reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the Grant-Aided Secondary Schools (Scotland) Grant Regulations 1976(b) and, unless the context otherwise requires, expressions used in these regulations shall have the same meaning in these regulations as they have in the principal regulations.

Amendment of the principal regulations

3. Schedule 1 (maintenance grants) to the principal regulations shall be amended by the insertion therein, under the heading "Column (7)" and sub-heading "Financial Year Ending in 1981", of the amounts specified in Column (B) of the Schedule to these regulations, opposite such of the serial numbers specified in Column (1) of Schedule 1 to the principal regulations, as are specified in Column (A) of the Schedule to these regulations.

Revocation of the principal regulations

4. Regulations 4(2)(b), 5 and 10 of the principal regulations are hereby revoked and in so far as the principal regulations relate to the specified school known as St. Mary's Music School (Serial number 8 of Column (1) of Schedule 1 to the principal regulations) the principal regulations are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations further amend the Grant-Aided Secondary Schools (Scotland) Regulations 1976 by inserting in the Schedule to the 1976 Regulations amounts for purposes of calculation of maintenance grant in respect of any financial year ending in 1981. Regulations 4(2)(b), 5 and 10 of the 1976 Regulations are revoked and the 1976 Regulations are revoked so far as they relate to St. Mary's Music School, Edinburgh.
