## HOUSING, ENGLAND AND WALES

**The Approved Expenditure (Housing Act 1974 Part IV)  
Order 1980**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	<i>9th June 1980</i>
<i>Laid before the House of Commons</i>	<i>1st July 1980</i>
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	<i>22nd July 1980</i>

The Secretary of State for the Environment as respects England, and the Secretary of State for Wales as respects Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 46(6) and (7) of the Housing Act 1974(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and with the consent of the Treasury, hereby make the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Approved Expenditure (Housing Act 1974 Part IV) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 22nd July 1980.

2. The sum of £50 specified in section 46(4) of the Housing Act 1974 is hereby varied by the substitution for that sum of the sum of £400.

This Order increases from £50 to £400 the amount per dwelling which is to be taken into account in calculating the maximum approved expenditure by local authorities under Part IV of the Housing Act in respect of housing action areas towards which contributions may be paid by the Secretaries of State.
