HOUSING, ENGLAND AND WALES**The Approved Expenditure (Housing Act 1969 Part II) Order 1980**

Made - - - - - *9th June 1980*

Coming into Operation *22nd July 1980*

The Secretary of State for the Environment (**a**) as respects England and the Secretary of State for Wales as respects Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 37(5) of the Housing Act 1969 (**b**) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, with the consent of the Treasury, hereby make the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Approved Expenditure (Housing Act 1969 Part II) Order 1980 and shall come into operation on 22nd July 1980.

2. In section 37(4) of the Housing Act 1969 (calculation of approved expenditure of local authorities in respect of general improvement areas) for the amount of £200 there shall be substituted the amount of £400.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order increases from £200 (substituted by the Approved Expenditure (Housing Act 1969 Part II) Order 1972, S.I. No. 440, for the original figure of £100) to £400 the amount per dwelling which is to be taken into account in calculating the maximum approved expenditure by local authorities under Part II of the Housing Act 1969 in respect of general improvement areas towards which contributions may be paid by the Secretaries of State.
