**Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 3)
 (Protection of Trading Interests Act 1980) 1980**

Made - - - - 26th June 1980

Coming into Operation 17th July 1980

The Lords of Council and Session under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by section 16 of the Administration of Justice (Scotland) Act 1933(a) and of all other powers competent to them in that behalf, do hereby enact and declare—

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This Act of Sederunt may be cited as the Act of Sederunt (Rules of Court Amendment No. 3) (Protection of Trading Interests Act 1980) 1980 and shall come into operation on 17th July 1980.

(2) This Act of Sederunt shall be inserted in the Books of Sederunt.

Amendment to Rules of Court

2. In the Rules of Court(b)—

(a) in rule 248 (Petitions under Administration of Justice Act 1920), in paragraph (b) after the word “statute” add the following words—

“and that the judgment which it is sought to be registered is not a judgment to which section 5 of the Protection of Trading Interests Act 1980 applies”;

(b) in rule 249 (Petitions under the Foreign Judgments (Reciprocal Enforcement) Act 1933), in paragraph 2, at the end of sub-paragraph

(1)(b), add the following head—

“(v) that the judgment is not a judgment to which section 5 of the Protection of Trading Interests Act 1980 applies.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Act of Sederunt.)

This Act of Sederunt amends the Rules of Court in relation to petitions to register judgments under the Administration of Justice Act 1920 and the Foreign Judgments (Reciprocal Enforcement) Act 1933 in consequence of the exclusion from registration under these Acts of Judgments to which section 5 of the Protection of Trading Interests Act 1980 applies.
