**The Meat and Livestock Commission Levy (Variation)
Scheme (Confirmation) Order 1981**

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretary of State concerned with agriculture in Scotland and the Secretary of State for Wales, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 13 of the Agriculture Act 1967(a), and now vested in them (b), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, being satisfied that the bringing into force of a scheme submitted to them by the Meat and Livestock Commission for their confirmation under the said section is desirable, which scheme is set out in the Schedule to this order and varies the scheme confirmed by the Meat and Livestock Commission Levy Scheme (Confirmation) Order 1979 (c), hereby make the following order, a draft whereof has been laid before Parliament and approved by resolution of each House of Parliament:—

1. This order may be cited as the Meat and Livestock Commission Levy (Variation) Scheme (Confirmation) Order 1981 and shall come into operation on the day after the day on which it is made.

2. The scheme set out in the Schedule to this order is hereby confirmed and shall come into force on 1st October 1981.

Article 2

SCHEDULE

MEAT AND LIVESTOCK COMMISSION LEVY (VARIATION) SCHEME
1981

The Meat and Livestock Commission Levy Scheme, which is set out in the Schedule to the Meat and Livestock Commission Levy Scheme (Confirmation) Order 1979, is hereby varied by substituting in paragraph 4(2) thereof (which specifies the maximum charges leviable under the scheme)—

- (a) for the words "90p a head" the words "£1 a head";
- (b) for the words "16p a head" the words "24p a head"; and
- (c) for the words "30p a head" the words "40p a head".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order confirms a scheme submitted to the Ministers making the order by the Meat and Livestock Commission. The scheme, which comes into force on 1st October 1981, varies the Meat and Livestock Commission Levy Scheme by increasing the maximum charges which may be imposed by the Commission in respect of livestock slaughtered or exported.

The maximum charges are increased—

- (a) in respect of cattle (other than calves not exceeding 68kg deadweight) from 90p a head to £1 a head,
- (b) in respect of sheep from 16p a head to 24p a head, and
- (c) in respect of pigs from 30p a head to 40p a head.

The maximum charge of 12p a head for calves not exceeding 68kg deadweight is not changed.
