DANGEROUS DRUGS**The Misuse of Drugs (Licence Fees) (Amendment)****Regulations 1981***Made - - - - - 6th February 1981**Laid before Parliament 17th February 1981**Coming into Operation 1st April 1981*

In pursuance of sections 30 and 31 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971(a), and after consultation with the Advisory Council on the Misuse of Drugs, I hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs (Licence Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1981 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1981.

2. Regulation 3(1) of the Misuse of Drugs (Licence Fees) Regulations 1979(b) shall be amended as follows:—

- (a) in sub-paragraph (a), for “£174” there shall be substituted “£210”;
- (b) in sub-paragraph (b), for “£116” there shall be substituted “£140”;
- (c) in sub-paragraph (c), for “£58” there shall be substituted “£70”;
- (d) in sub-paragraph (d), for “£58” there shall be substituted “£70”; and
- (e) in sub-paragraph (e), for “£29” there shall be substituted “£35”.
