**The Companies (Inspectors' Reports) (Fees) Regulations 1981**

*Made - - - - 24th November 1981  
22nd December  
Coming into Operation 1981*

The Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 168(2) and 455(1) of the Companies Act 1948(1), and now vested in him(2), hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Companies (Inspectors' Reports) (Fees) Regulations 1981 and shall come into operation on 22nd December 1981.

2. The fee prescribed for the furnishing of a copy of a report under section 168(2) of the Companies Act 1948 or for furnishing a copy of a report or part of a report under that section as it applies for the purposes of section 172 of that Act(3) shall be 10 pence for each page copied.
