**The Diseases of Animals (Fees for the Testing of Disinfectants)
Order 1981**

Made - - - - - 30th November 1981

*Laid before the
House of Commons* 8th December 1981

Coming into Operation 29th December 1981

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, the Secretary of State for Scotland and the Secretary of State for Wales, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 84(1) of the Animal Health Act 1981(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, with the approval of the Treasury, hereby order as follows:—

Citation, extent, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This order, which may be cited as the Diseases of Animals (Fees for the Testing of Disinfectants) Order 1981, shall apply to Great Britain and shall come into operation on 29th December 1981.

(2) In this order “the Order of 1978” means the Diseases of Animals (Approved Disinfectants) Order 1978(b).

Fees for the testing of disinfectants

2. There shall be payable to the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food in respect of the testing, in pursuance of Article 7(1) of the Order of 1978, of any disinfectant submitted for the purpose of having such disinfectant listed as approved in Schedule 1 to that Order the fees set out in the Schedule to this order.

Revocation

3. The Diseases of Animals (Fees for the Testing of Disinfectants) Order 1980(c) is hereby revoked.
