**The Anglian Water Authority (River Pant Discharge)  
Order 1981**

*Made* - - - - 11th December 1981

*Coming into Operation* 28th December 1981

The Secretary of State for the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 1 of the Water Resources Act 1971(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:

1. This order may be cited as the Anglian Water Authority (River Pant Discharge) Order 1981 and shall come into operation on 28th December 1981. Citation and commencement.

2. In this order unless the context otherwise requires— Interpretation.  
“day” means any period of 24 hours;

“the deposited map” means the map prepared in duplicate signed by an Under Secretary in the Department of the Environment and marked “Map referred to in the Anglian Water Authority (River Pant Discharge) Order 1981” one duplicate of which is deposited and is available for inspection at the offices of the Authority’s Essex River Division, Rivers House, Springfield Road, Chelmsford, Essex CM2 6JN and the other at the offices of the Secretary of State for the Environment;

“the Great Sampford Outfall” means an outfall to the River Pant in the Parish of Great Sampford in the District of Uttlesford in the County of Essex being Work No. 19 constructed under the Ely Ouse-Essex Water Act 1968(b) and owned by the Anglian Water Authority.

3. The Anglian Water Authority are hereby authorised to discharge water at a rate not exceeding 5,000 cubic metres per day from an existing borehole at National Grid reference TL 64563512 in the Parish of Great Sampford in the District of Uttlesford in the County of Essex via a pipeline leading to the aqueduct comprised in the Great Sampford Outfall and via that aqueduct into the River Pant in the said Parish of Great Sampford at a discharge point at National Grid Reference TL 64593511 and indicated on the deposited map. Discharge of water.
