The East of Birmingham-Birkenhead Trunk Road (Sandford Diversion) Order 1981

Made - - -

31st December 1981

Coming into Operation

22nd January 1982

The Secretary of State for Transport makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by sections 10 and 41 of the Highways Act 1980(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other enabling powers:—

- 1. The new highway which the Secretary of State proposes to construct along the route described in Schedule 1 to this Order shall become a trunk road as from the date when this Order comes into operation.
- 2. The centre line of the new trunk road is indicated by a heavy black line on the deposited plan.
- 3. The length of the Trunk Road described in Schedule 2 to this Order and shown by broad striped hatching on the deposited plan shall cease to be a trunk road from the date on which the Secretary of State notifies the County Council of Shropshire that the new trunk road is open for through traffic.
 - 4. In this Order:-
 - (1) all measurements of the distances are measured along the route of the relevant highway:
 - (2) (i) "the deposited plan" means the plan numbered HA10/2WM82A marked "The East of Birmingham-Birkenhead Trunk Road (Sandford Diversion) Order 1981" signed by authority of the Secretary of State and deposited at the Department of Transport, Romney House, 43 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3PY;
 - (ii) "the new trunk road" means the highway mentioned in Article
 1 of this Order; and
 - (iii) "the Trunk Road" means the East of Birmingham-Birkenhead Trunk Road (A41).
- 5. This Order shall come into operation on 22nd January 1982 and may be cited as the East of Birmingham-Birkenhead Trunk Road (Sandford Diversion) Order 1981.

SCHEDULE 1

The route of the new trunk road is at Sandford in the County of Shropshire, about 1100 metres in length, starting at a point on the Trunk Road 150 metres north-west of its junction with the B5065 then going south-eastwards to rejoin the Trunk Road.

SCHEDULE 2

That length of the Trunk Road which extends from a point 30 metres east of its junction with the B5065 eastwards for 390 metres.

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
