**The Veterinary Surgeons Qualifications (EEC Recognition)
(Greek Qualifications) Order 1981**

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 18th day of February 1981

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas, by the Act concerning the conditions of accession of the Hellenic Republic and the adjustments to the Treaties establishing the European Coal and Steel Community, the European Economic Community and the European Atomic Energy Community(a), adaptation was made to the European Communities Council Directive concerning the mutual recognition of diplomas, certificates and other evidence of formal qualifications in veterinary medicine(b) to add to that Directive particulars of qualifications awarded in the Hellenic Republic:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972(c) is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Veterinary Surgeons Qualifications (EEC Recognition) (Greek Qualifications) Order 1981 and shall come into operation on 19th March 1981.

Recognition of Greek qualifications in veterinary medicine

2. There shall be inserted in Schedule 1A to the Veterinary Surgeons Act 1966(a) after the entry relating to Germany the following—

“Greece

Δίπλωμα Κτηνιατρικής Σχολής του Πανεπιστημίου
Θεσσαλονίκης (the diploma of the faculty of veterinary
medicine at the University of Thessaloniki).”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order is made under the European Communities Act 1972 and comes into operation on 19th March 1981. The Order amends the Veterinary Surgeons Act 1966 so as to take into account the amendments to the European Communities Council Directive relating to the right of establishment of veterinary surgeons and their freedom to provide services, made necessary by the accession of Greece to the European Economic Community.

The Order amends Schedule 1A to the Veterinary Surgeons Act 1966 so as to include a reference to Greek qualifications in veterinary medicine.
