At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 18th day of February 1981
 Present,
 The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by sections 2, 17 and 21 of the Extradition Act 1870 (a) and sections 5(2) and 27(1) of the Protection of Aircraft Act 1973 (b), or otherwise in Her Majesty vested, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Extradition (Protection of Aircraft) (Amendment) Order 1981 and shall come into operation on 19th March 1981.

2. The Extradition (Protection of Aircraft) Order 1973 (c) shall be amended by adding to Schedule 2 (which names the foreign States with which the United Kingdom has extradition treaties in force and which are parties to the Convention for the Suppression of Unlawful Acts against the Safety of Civil Aviation signed at Montreal on 23rd September 1971 (d)) the following entries:—

3. The Extradition (Protection of Aircraft) Order 1973 shall be amended by adding to Part I of Schedule 3 (which names the foreign States with which the United Kingdom has no extradition treaties in force and which are parties to the Convention for the Suppression of Unlawful Acts against the Safety of Civil Aviation signed at Montreal on 23rd September 1971) the following entries:—

4. The Extradition (Protection of Aircraft) Order 1973 shall be amended by deleting from Schedule 4 (which names the territories to which the application of the Convention for the Suppression of Unlawful Acts against the Safety of Civil Aviation signed at Montreal on 23rd September 1971 is extended) the entry for the Gilbert Islands.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Extradition (Protection of Aircraft) Order 1973 (which among its provisions names States party to the Convention for the Suppression of Unlawful Acts against the Safety of Civil Aviation signed at Montreal on 23rd September 1971) by adding the names of the States specified in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order which are also parties to the Montreal Convention. This Order also amends Schedule 4 to the 1973 Order so as to omit the entry for the Gilbert Islands, which have attained independence.
