The Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages (Fees)
Order 1981

The Secretary of State for Social Services, in exercise of powers conferred by section 5(1) to (3) of and Schedule 3 to the Public Expenditure and Receipts Act 1968^(a) and now vested in him ^(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages (Fees) Order 1981 and shall come into operation, for the purposes of this Article and Articles 2 and 4, on 1st April 1981 and for the purposes of Article 3, on 1st July 1981.

Variation of fees from 1st April 1981

2. The enactments specified in column 2 of the Schedule (which relate to the fees payable in respect of the matters mentioned in column 3 of the Schedule) shall be amended, where the sum specified in column 5 of the Schedule to this Order differs from that specified in column 4 of the Schedule, by substituting for the sum specified in column 4 of the Schedule the sum specified in column 5 thereof.

Variation of fees from 1st July 1981

3. The enactments specified in column 2 of the Schedule (which relate to the fees payable in respect of the matters mentioned in column 3 of the Schedule) shall be amended, where the sum specified in column 6 of the Schedule to this Order differs from that specified in column 5 of the Schedule, by substituting for the sum specified in column 5 of the Schedule the sum specified in column 6 thereof.
