TRADE MARKS

The Trade Marks (Amendment) Rules 1981

Made -20th February 1981 Laid before Parliament 25th February 1981 Coming into Operation Rules 1 and 3 -18th March 1981 Rule 2 14th April 1981

Whereas, in pursuance of the requirements of section 40(3) of the Trade Marks Act 1938(a), the Secretary of State has, before making the following Rules under that Act, published notice of his intention to make such Rules and of the place where copies of the draft Rules might be obtained by advertising such notice in the Trade Marks Journal and the Official Journal (Patents) on 28th January 1981 and 4th February 1981, being the manner which he considered most expedient so as to enable persons affected to make representations to him before the Rules were finally settled:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by sections 40 and 41 of the Trade Marks Act 1938 and now vested in him(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and with the sanction of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Rules:-

- 1. These Rules may be cited as the Trade Marks (Amendment) Rules 1981 and shall come into operation as respects rules 1 and 3 on 18th March 1981 and as respects rule 2 on 14th April 1981.
- 2. For Schedule 1 to the Trade Marks Rules 1938(c) there shall be substituted the Schedule hereto and the Trade Marks (Amendment) Rules 1980(d) shall thereupon be revoked.
- 3. Where on or after 18th March 1981 but before 14th April 1981 Form T.M. No. 11 is filed in respect of the renewal of registration of a trade mark or a series of trade marks the last registration of which mark or series of marks is due to expire on or after 14th April 1981, the fee payable in respect of such renewal shall be that which would be payable if the said form were filed on or after 14th April 1981 and rule 2 of these Rules had come into operation.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Rules.)

These Rules further amend the Trade Marks Rules 1938 so as to increase certain fees payable under them. The new fees become payable on or after 14th April 1981, except in the case of renewal fees paid in advance in respect of the period beginning on or after 14th April 1981, which are increased with effect from 18th March 1981.

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
