**Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland)**  
**Order 1981**

The Secretary of State being satisfied as respects the area hereinafter mentioned that certain waters are infected waters, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2(1) as read with section 11 of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937(a), and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

*Citation and Commencement*

1. This order may be cited as the Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland) Order 1981 and shall come into operation on 30th March 1981.

*Infected Area*

2. The area comprising Finnarts Bay Fish Farm owned by the Shearwater Fish Farming Co Ltd enclosed in a triangle between OS Grid References 047729, 055729 and 052723 is hereby declared to be an infected area for the purposes of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937.

*Control of Movement of Fish etc*

3. No person shall without the previous consent in writing of the Secretary of State move out of the area declared by Article 2 above to be an infected area any live fish or eggs of fish or foodstuff for fish.
