Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland) (No. 4)
Order 1981

Made - - - - - 24th March 1981

Coming into operation 30th March 1981

The Secretary of State being satisfied as respects the areas hereinafter mentioned that certain waters are infected waters, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2(1) as read with section 11 of the Diseases of Fish Act, 1937(a) and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland) (No. 4) Order 1981 and shall come into operation on 30th March 1981.

Infected areas

2. The following areas *viz*

(a) the area of sea enclosed by a line joining the headlands at OS Grid References 012327 and 022329 and the southern shore at the highwater mark; and

(b) the area of land enclosed by a line commencing at the Weir on the eastern bank of the River Awe, near Grid Reference 016319, and proceeding in an easterly direction to Grid Reference 025319; thereafter in a southerly direction to Grid Reference 021313; and thereafter due west to the point of intersection with the eastern bank of the River Awe and thereafter following that bank northwards to the point of the beginning

being areas comprising fish farms owned by Lorne Fisheries Ltd are hereby declared to be infected areas for the purposes of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937.

Control of movement of fish etc

3. No person shall without the previous consent in writing of the Secretary of State for Scotland move out of the area declared by Article 2 above to be an infected area any live fish or eggs of fish or foodstuff for fish.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order declares the fish farms owned by Lorne Fisheries Ltd lying within the areas described in this Order to be infected areas for the purposes of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937 and prohibits the movement out of the areas of any live fish, eggs of fish or foodstuff for fish.
