**The St. Mary's Music School (Scotland)
Grant Amendment Regulations 1981**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 73(c) of the Education (Scotland) Act 1980(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the St. Mary's Music School (Scotland) Grant Amendment Regulations 1981 and shall come into operation on 31st July 1981.

Interpretation

2. In these regulations, a reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the St. Mary's Music School (Scotland) Grant Regulations 1980(b) and, unless the context otherwise requires, expressions used in these regulations shall have the same meaning in these regulations as they have in the principal regulations.

Amendment of the principal regulations

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), in regulation 3(1) of the principal regulations, for "1981" there shall be substituted "1982" and in regulation 3(2) of those regulations for "£30,000" there shall be substituted "£39,000".

(2) Nothing in this regulation shall affect the operation of the principal regulations and in particular regulation 3(1) and (2) of the principal regulations, as originally made, in relation to any application made by the managers of the school in accordance with regulation 3(1) as so made.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations amend the St. Mary's Music School (Scotland) Grant Regulations 1980 to relate to the financial year of the school ending in 1982 and by amending the provision made for the purposes of calculation of maintenance grant in respect of that year.
