**The Revocation of Instrument of Management
(Finnart House School) Order 1981**

Made - - - - - *22nd April 1981*

Coming into Operation *15th May 1981*

Whereas the Trustees of Finnart House School have given not less than 2 years notice in writing to the Secretary of State and to the London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham of their intention to cease to provide the controlled community home known as Finnart House School, as from 29th September 1982;

And whereas the body of managers of the aforesaid home have given notice in writing to the Secretary of State that they are unwilling to continue as managers of the home until the date specified in the first mentioned notices;

Now therefore the Secretary of State for Social Services in exercise of his powers under section 43(4) of the Child Care Act 1980(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Revocation of Instrument of Management (Finnart House School) Order 1981 and shall come into operation on 15th May 1981.

(2) In this order, “the home” means the controlled community home known as Finnart House School and situate at Weybridge, Surrey.

Revocation of Instrument of Management

2. The Finnart House School Instrument of Management Order 1973 and the Finnart House School Instrument of Management (Variation) Order 1975 are hereby revoked.

Conduct of the Home

3. The London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham shall conduct the home until 30th June 1981 as if it were a community home provided by the aforesaid Borough.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This order revokes the Instrument of Management for the controlled community home known as Finnart House School as from 15th May 1981 and makes provision for the London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham to run the home as if it were a community home provided by the Borough from that date until 30th June 1981.
