The Wild Birds (Aberdeen Airport) Order 1981

Made - - - - - 15th April 1981

Coming into Operation 16th April 1981

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 9(1) of the Protection of Birds Act 1954(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after consulting the Advisory Committee on the Protection of Birds for Scotland and giving an opportunity to submit objections or representations in accordance with section 13(2)(a) and (b) of the said Act, I hereby make the following order:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Wild Birds (Aberdeen Airport) Order 1981 and shall come into operation on 16th April 1981.

(2) This order shall apply with respect to Aberdeen Airport, Dyce, Aberdeen, only.

2. The Oystercatcher, the Lapwing, the Common Gull and the Black-headed Gull are hereby added to Schedule 2 to the Protection of Birds Act 1954.

This Order will allow Oystercatchers, Lapwings, Common Gulls and Black-headed Gulls to be killed or taken or their nests or eggs to be destroyed or taken, by authorised persons except on Sundays and on Christmas Day, within the area of Aberdeen Airport, Dyce, Aberdeen.
