**CIVIL AVIATION**

**The Civil Aviation Act 1980 (Commencement) Order 1981**

*Made* - - - *29th April 1981*

Whereas the Civil Aviation Authority has published(a) the first statement of its policies under section 13 of the Civil Aviation Act 1980(b):

Now therefore the Secretary of State, in exercise of his powers under section 12(6) of the Civil Aviation Act 1980 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Civil Aviation Act 1980 (Commencement) Order 1981.

2. 22nd May 1981 is hereby appointed as the day on which section 12 of the Civil Aviation Act 1980, and the repeal of section 24(2) of the Civil Aviation Act 1971(c) provided for in Schedule 3 to the 1980 Act, shall come into force.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order appoints 22nd May 1981 as the day on which section 12 of the Civil Aviation Act 1980 shall come into force. Section 12 repeals the provisions of the Civil Aviation Act 1971 empowering the Secretary of State to give guidance to the Civil Aviation Authority with respect to the Authority's functions and makes other amendments to the 1971 Act relating to the general objectives and licensing functions of the Authority. With the exception of these provisions, the Act came into force on Royal Assent (13th November 1980).
