Her Majesty, in pursuance of section 5(4) of the Parliamentary Commissioner Act 1967(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Parliamentary Commissioner Order 1981 and shall come into operation on 11th June 1981.

2. In Schedule 3 to the Parliamentary Commissioner Act 1967, in paragraph 8(b), after the words "a special health authority" there shall be inserted the words "except the Rampton Hospital Review Board".

This Order amends Schedule 3 to the Parliamentary Commissioner Act 1967, which sets out matters which are not subject to investigation by the Parliamentary Commissioner for Administration, so as to exclude from the provisions of that Schedule any action taken on behalf of the Secretary of State for Social Services by the Rampton Hospital Review Board.
