In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 96(1) of the Glasgow Corporation Consolidation (General Powers) Order Confirmation Act 1960(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. This order may be cited as the City of Glasgow District Council (Common Lodging-Houses) (Charges) Order 1981 and shall come into operation on 1st August 1981.

Alteration of maximum nightly rate for common lodging-houses

- 2. Section 96(1) of the Glasgow Corporation Consolidation (General Powers) Order Confirmation Act 1960 as amended(b) (which defines the expression "common lodging-house") shall have effect with the substitution of "£1.70" for "£1.30" in paragraph (a)(i) thereof.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends as from 1st August 1981 the definition of common lodging-house in the Glasgow Corporation Consolidation (General Powers) Order Confirmation Act 1960 by making it applicable, in that area of Glasgow to which the 1960 Order applies, to a house or part thereof in which any person is lodged at a nightly rate not exceeding £1.70 rather than £1.30 as hitherto.
