CORN CROPS

The Corn Returns (Scotland) (Amendment) Regulations 1981

Made - - - - - *10th June 1981*
Coming into Operation *1st August 1981*

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 4, 5 and 14 of the Corn Returns Act 1882(a) and now vested in me(b), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation interpretation, extent and commencement

- 1.** These regulations, which may be cited as the Corn Returns (Scotland) (Amendment) Regulations 1981, shall be construed as one with the Corn Returns (Scotland) Regulations 1976(c) (in these regulations referred to as "the principal regulations"), shall apply to Scotland only and shall come into operation on 1st August 1981.

Amendment of principal regulations

- 2.** The principal regulations shall be further amended by substituting for Schedule 2 thereto (which sets out the form of return required by those regulations) the Schedule to these regulations.

Revocation

- 3.** The Corn Returns (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1979(d) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations further amend the Corn Returns (Scotland) Regulations 1976 by substituting a new form of return for the previous form set out in the Corn Returns (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1979. The principal changes are the deletion of one section of the previous form and the amalgamation of the remaining two sections so that all the information required is now in one section.
