**The Rampton Hospital Review Board (Functions and
Membership) Amendment Regulations 1982**

Made - - - - 5th January 1982

Laid before Parliament 15th January 1982

Coming into Operation 5th February 1982

The Secretary of State for Social Services in exercise of powers conferred upon him by section 12 of, and paragraph 12 of Schedule 5 to, the National Health Service Act 1977(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Rampton Hospital Review Board (Functions and Membership) Amendment Regulations 1982 and shall come into operation on 5th February 1982.

Amendment of Regulations

2. For paragraph (2) of regulation 8 of the Rampton Hospital Review Board (Functions and Membership) Regulations 1981(b) there shall be substituted the following paragraph—

“(2) The provisions of regulation 4(4) to (6) (termination of tenure of office), regulation 7 (disqualification for appointment) and regulation 8 (cessation of disqualification) of the National Health Service (Health Authorities: Membership) Regulations 1981(c) shall apply in relation to the Board as if any reference therein to an Authority were a reference to the Board.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

The Rampton Hospital Review Board (Functions and Membership) Regulations 1981 are amended by these regulations so as to take account of a consolidation with amendments effected by the National Health Service (Health Authorities: Membership) Regulations 1981 of certain provisions relating to termination of tenure of office, disqualification for appointment and cessation of such disqualification. The principal amendments are—

- (a) the disqualification of a person by reason of his bankruptcy will cease in cases in which he is treated as having been discharged by virtue of section 7 of the Insolvency Act 1976 (c. 60), and
- (b) power is given to the Secretary of State to remove the disqualification of a person who was disqualified by reason of dismissal from employment with certain bodies.
