# The Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland) Revocation Order 1982

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2(1) as read with section 11 of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, being satisfied, as respects the area comprising the fish farm at Ormsary, Kintyre, owned by Inver Salmon Ltd, that the waters therein are no longer infected waters, hereby makes the following order:—

#### Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland) Revocation Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 28th April 1982.

### Revocation of order

2. The Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland) (No. 10) Order 1981 (b) is hereby revoked.
