1. This order may be cited as the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1982.

2. Section 25 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982 and section 47 of that Act, so far as it relates to section 63 of the Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974(b), shall come into operation on the 1st September 1982.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This order brings into effect, on 1st September 1982, amendments to section 64 and 65 of the Public Health Act 1936 (c.49) (which relate to the passing or rejection of plans deposited under the building regulations) and the repeal of sub-sections (1) to (4) of section 63 of the Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974.
