1. The Secretary of State is authorised to provide for the use of traffic of Classes I and II of the classes of traffic set out in Schedule 4 to the Highways Act 1980 a special road along the route described in the Schedule to this Scheme.

2. The centre line of the special road is indicated by a heavy black line on the deposited plan.

3. The special road shall become a trunk road on the date when this Scheme comes into operation.

4. In this Scheme:-

"the deposited plan"	means the plan numbered HA 16/1 EMRO(L) V marked "The M42 Birmingham—Nottingham Motorway (Curdworth to Appleby Magna Section) and Connecting Roads Supplementary Scheme 1982" signed by authority of the Secretary of State and deposited at the Department of Transport, Romney House, Marsham Street, London SW1P 3PY;		
"the special road"	means the special road mentioned in Article 1 of this Scheme;		

5. This Scheme shall come into operation on 24th September 1982, and may be cited as the M42 Birmingham—Nottingham Motorway (Curdworth to Appleby Magna Section) and Connecting Roads Supplementary Scheme 1982.
