CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Erewash (Parishes) Order 1982

<i>Made</i> - - - - -	31st August 1982
<i>Coming into Operation—</i>

<i>in article 2</i> - - - -	1st January 1983
<i>for all other purposes</i> -	1st April 1983

Whereas the Borough Council of Erewash, under section 48(8) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), made recommendations to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for proposals in relation to parishes in the borough;

And whereas the said Commission, under sections 47 and 51(1) of the said Act, on 29th May 1981, made such proposals to the Secretary of State for the Environment:

Now therefore the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) of the said Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order giving effect to the said proposals with modifications:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Erewash (Parishes) Order 1982.

2. 1st January 1983 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purposes set out in regulation 4(1) (Coming into operation of order) of the Regulations.

For all other purposes this order shall come into operation on the appointed day.

Interpretation

3. In this order—

“the appointed day” means 1st April 1983;

“the county” means the County of Derbyshire;

“the borough” means the Borough of Erewash, and “the borough council” means the council of the borough;

“the Regulations” means the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(a) as amended by the Local Government Area Changes (Amendment) Regulations 1978(b); and

“Schedule 1” and “Schedule 2” mean Schedule 1 and Schedule 2 to this order.

The boundary maps

4. In this order—

“the boundary maps” means the 3 maps printed for Her Majesty’s Stationery Office by Ordnance Survey, each such map being marked “Map referred to in the Erewash (Parishes) Order 1982” and with the number of the map; and any reference to a numbered boundary map is a reference to the map described and numbered as aforesaid.

Changes in areas

5.—(1) The parts of parishes described in column (1) of Schedule 1 and marked on the boundary maps as specified in column (2) shall, in so far as parishes, electoral divisions of the county and wards of the borough are specified in respect thereof in columns (3) to (5), be transferred to or form part of such areas.

(2) The parts of the Parish of Breaston marked B1a, B1b and B1c on boundary map 3 shall cease to form part of any parish and shall form part of the Sawley electoral division of the county. The part marked B1a shall form part of the Wilsthorpe ward of the borough, the parts marked B1b and B1c shall form part of the Sawley ward.

(3) The parts of the area of the former urban district of Long Eaton marked on the boundary maps as specified in column (1) of Schedule 2 shall form part of the parishes, electoral divisions of the county and wards of the borough specified in respect thereof in columns (2) to (4).

Statutory definitions of areas

6. In any application of sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph (1) (certain definitions of areas) of regulation 40 of the Regulations, the areas to which article 5(2) applies shall be deemed to have been added to the area of the former urban district of Long Eaton, and the areas to which article 5(3) applies shall be deemed to have ceased to form part of such area.

Local Acts, orders and byelaws

7.—(1) The area of the former urban district of Long Eaton shall be a relevant area within the meaning of regulation 41 (Local Acts, orders and byelaws) of the Regulations and is hereby specified in relation to paragraph (4) of that regulation, and the area comprising—

the first mentioned area other than the parts thereof to which article 5(3) applies; and

the areas to which article 5(2) applies,

is hereby specified in relation to the first mentioned area.

(2) The provision of paragraph (1) is without prejudice to the operation of regulation 41(3) of the Regulations in respect of any parish as altered.

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

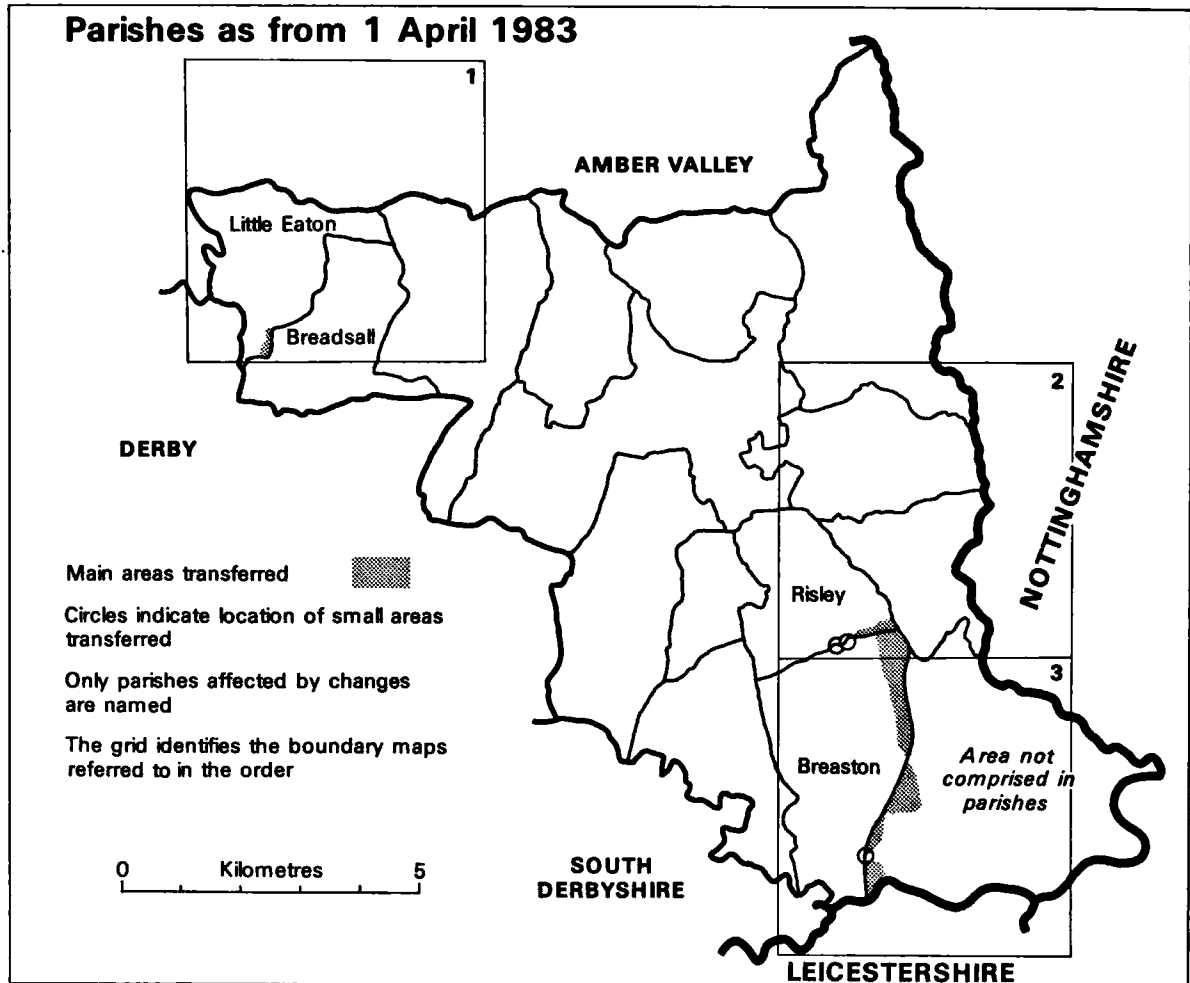
This order effects some adjustments between parishes, and between parishes and a part of the borough not comprised in any parish, in the Borough of Erewash.
