**The Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland) Revocation  
(No. 2) Order 1982**

The Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2(1) as read with section 11 of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937(a), and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, being satisfied as respects the area comprising Finnarts Bay Fish Farm enclosed in a triangle between OS Grid References 047729, 055729, 052723 and owned by Glen App Fisheries Limited that the waters therein are no longer infected, hereby makes the following order:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland) Revocation (No. 2) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 18th September 1982.

*Revocation of order*

2. The Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland) Order 1981(b) is hereby revoked. ,
