1. This Order may be cited as the Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland) Revocation (No. 2) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 18th September 1982.

2. The Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland) Order 1981(b) is hereby revoked.
