

1982 No. 1350**SOCIAL SECURITY****The Social Security (No. 2) Act 1980 Specified Sum Order 1982**

Made - - - - 20th September 1982

The Secretary of State for Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 6(2)(b) of the Social Security (No. 2) Act 1980(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Social Security (No. 2) Act 1980 Specified Sum Order 1982.

Increase of sum specified in section 6(1)(b) of the Social Security (No. 2) Act 1980

2. In section 6 of the Social Security (No. 2) Act 1980 (supplementary benefit in cases affected by trade disputes) the sum which, by reference to the Social Security Benefits Up-rating Order 1982(b), is, with effect from 22nd November 1982 (the date on which that Order comes into operation), substituted for the sum of £13 specified in subsection (1)(b) of that section is the sum of £14.50.

Revocation

3. The Social Security (No. 2) Act 1980 Specified Sum Order 1981(c) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order states the sum to which the sum specified in section 6(1)(b) of the Social Security (No. 2) Act 1980 is, by virtue of the operation of the Social Security Benefits Up-rating Order 1982, automatically increased (from £13 to £14.50). Under that section 6(1), payment of supplementary pension or allowance to or in respect of a person affected by a trade dispute is not made if the weekly rate is equal to or less than the sum specified and is made at a rate equal to the difference if the weekly rate is more than the sum specified. This Order revokes the Social Security (No. 2) Act 1980 Specified Sum Order 1981.
