The Anglian Water Authority (Mumby) **Order 1982**

30th November 1982

Coming into Operation

17th December 1982

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of powers conferred by section 23 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Anglian Water Authority (Mumby) Citation and Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 17th December 1982.

- (2) This order shall be included among the enactments which may be cited together as the Anglian Water Authority Act and Orders 1974 to 1982.
 - In this order, unless the context otherwise requires—

Interpretation.

"the Authority" means the Anglian Water Authority;

"the deposited plan" means the plan prepared in duplicate, signed by an Under Secretary in the Department of the Environment and marked "Plan referred to in the Anglian Water Authority (Mumby) Order 1982", one duplicate of which has been deposited and is available for inspection at the offices of the Authority's Lincoln Water Division at Waterside House, Waterside North, Lincoln LN2 5HA and the other at the offices of the Secretary of State for the Environment.

"the Third Schedule" means the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945:

"the undertaking" means the water undertaking of the Authority as for the time being authorised by any enactment.

3. For the purposes of this order the provisions of the Third Schedule Application which are set out in column (1) of Schedule 1 to this order shall, subject to of certain the modifications set out in column (2) thereof, apply to the undertaking third and are hereby incorporated with this order.

Schedule.

- 4. The Authority may in, on and under the land described in Schedule 2 to Power to this order-
 - (a) construct and maintain the works described in Schedule 3 to this works. order; and

construct and maintain

(b) construct and maintain on and under the said land (in addition to the works authorised by section 4 of the Third Schedule, as applied to the undertaking by this order) all such additional works as may be necessary or expedient for augmenting or improving the supply of water obtainable by means of the said works.

Works to form part of undertaking.

5. The works authorised by this order shall for all purposes form part of the undertaking.

PROVISIONS OF THE THIRD SCHEDULE APPLIED

Section 4 (General power to construct subsidiary works)	The words "and to any other provision of the special Act limiting the powers of the undertakers to abstract water" shall be omitted and for the words "any land for the time being held by them in connection with their water undertaking" there shall be substituted the words "the land described in the special Act".
Section 5 (Power of undertakers to lay or erect telephone wires, etc.)	_
Section 6 (Penalty for obstructing construction of works)	_
Section 92 (Liability of undertakers to pay compensation)	_

SCHEDULE 2

DESCRIPTION OF LAND

Land belonging to the Authority and having an area of 0.94 hectares or thereabouts incorporating enclosure numbers 6863 (part), 7158 (part) and 8262 (part), on the 1/2500 Ordnance Map Sheet TF 5074 5174 in the Parish of Mumby in the District of East Lindsey in the County of Lincoln, and more particularly delineated and coloured red on the deposited plan.

SCHEDULE 3

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

- Work No. 1 comprising an aeration tank, rapid gravity filters, filter gallery, washwater holding tank, control house, and incorporating associated plant and equipment, all which said works are delineated on the deposited plan and thereon collectively described as the "Treatment Complex".
- Work No. 2 comprising a covered tank and incorporating associated plant and equipment, all which said works are delineated on the deposited plan and thereon described as the "Treated Water Reservoir".
