The Social Security (Contributions)
Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1982

Laid before Parliament in draft

Made - - - - 3rd December 1982

Coming into Operation 6th April 1983

Whereas a draft of the following regulations was laid before Parliament in accordance with the provisions of section 167(1) of the Social Security Act 1975(a) and approved by resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State for Social Services in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 3(2)(a) of the Social Security Pensions Act 1975(b) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, without having referred any proposals on the matter to the Social Security Advisory Committee since it appears to him that by reason of urgency it is inexpedient to do so (c) hereby makes the following regulations:—

Citation, interpretation and commencement

1. These regulations, which may be cited as the Social Security (Contributions) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1982, amend the Social Security (Contributions) Regulations 1979(d) (hereinafter referred to as “the principal regulations”) and shall come into operation on 6th April 1983.

Amendment of regulation 104 of the principal regulations

2. In regulation 104 of the principal regulations (reduced rate of primary Class 1 contributions for married women and widows) for the words “3·2 per cent.” there shall be substituted the words “3·85 per cent.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations further amend the Social Security (Contributions) Regulations 1979. They increase the reduced rate of primary Class 1 contributions payable by married women and widows who have elected to pay such contributions at that reduced rate.

After these Regulations were laid before Parliament for approval by each House of Parliament, the Social Security Advisory Committee agreed that subsection (7) of section 10 of the Social Security Act 1980 (consultation with Committee on proposals for regulations) should not apply to these Regulations and accordingly they have not been referred to the Committee.
