**The National Health Service
(Charges to Overseas Visitors)
(Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1982**

Made - - - - - 29th November 1982

Laid before Parliament 10th December 1982

Coming into Operation 1st January 1983

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 98 of the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation and Commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the National Health Service (Charges to Overseas Visitors) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1982 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1983.

Amendment of the National Health Service (Charges to Overseas Visitors) (Scotland) Regulations 1982

2. Schedule 6 to the National Health Service (Charges to Overseas Visitors) (Scotland) Regulations 1982(b) shall be amended by adding to the list, set out therein, of countries or territories, in respect of which the United Kingdom Government has entered into a reciprocal agreement, the countries or territories—

Montserrat

Turks and Caicos Islands”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the National Health Service (Charges to Overseas Visitors) (Scotland) Regulations 1982 by adding to the list of countries or territories with which the United Kingdom Government has entered into reciprocal arrangements for health care, in accordance with which certain overseas visitors and certain treatments are exempted from charges under those Regulations. The countries or territories added are Anguilla, the British Virgin Islands, Iceland, Montserrat, St Helena and the Turks and Caicos Islands.

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
