CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Betchworth (Area) Order 1982

Made - - - - - 1st December 1982

*Coming into operation—
for the purposes des-

Whereas—

(1) the District Council of Mole Valley, under section 48(8) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), made recommendations to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for proposals in relation to parishes in the district;

(2) the said Commission, under sections 47 and 51(1) of the said Act, on 31st October 1980, made certain of such proposals to the Secretary of State for the Environment;

(3) the Mole Valley (Parishes) Order 1981(b) was made;

(4) the said Commission reaffirmed an intended further proposal and on 5th March 1982 made such proposal to the Secretary of State for the Environment:

Now therefore the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) of the said Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Betchworth (Area) Order 1982.

2. 1st January 1983 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purposes set out in regulation 4(1) (Coming into operation of order) of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(c) as amended by the Local Government Area Changes (Amendment) Regulations 1978(d).

For all other purposes this order shall come into operation on 1st April 1983.

Changes in areas

3.— (1) The part of the Parish of Betchworth which is shown coloured red on the boundary map shall—

- (a) cease to form part of any parish; and
- (b) form part of the Dorking North electoral division of the County of Surrey and of the Box Hill ward of the District of Mole Valley.

(2) In this article “the boundary map” means the map printed for Her Majesty’s Stationery Office by Ordnance Survey as “Map referred to in the Betchworth (Area) Order 1982”.

Statutory definitions of areas

4. In the provision set out in article 8 of the Mole Valley (Parishes) Order 1981, for “the area to which article 4(3) of the Mole Valley (Parishes) Order 1981 applies” there shall be substituted “the areas to which article 4(3) of the Mole Valley (Parishes) Order 1981 and article 3 of the Betchworth (Area) Order 1982 apply”.

Local Acts, orders and byelaws

5. In article 9(1) of the Mole Valley (Parishes) Order 1981, for “the area to which article 4(3) applies” there shall be substituted “the areas to which article 4(3) of this order and article 3 of the Betchworth (Area) Order 1982 apply”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

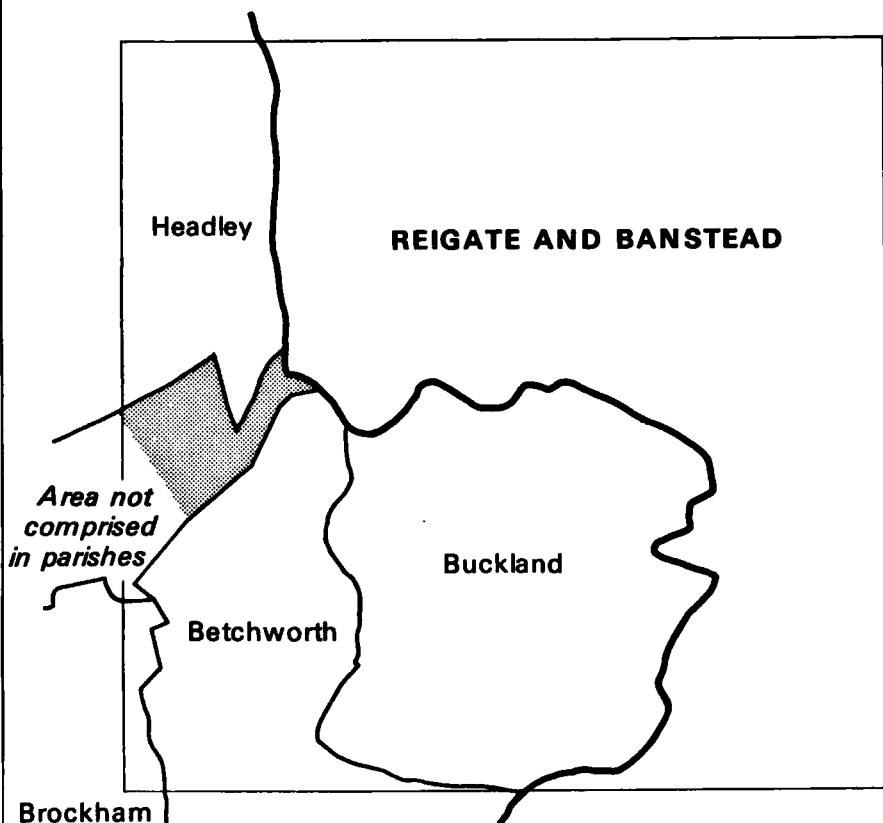
This order provides that part of the Parish of Betchworth in the District of Mole Valley shall cease to form part of any parish and shall form part of the Dorking North electoral division of the County of Surrey and of the Box Hill ward of the District. The area in question has an approximate area, population and rateable value of 75 hectares, 35 and £4,350 respectively.

The area dealt with is shown on the map forming part of this note.

Prints of the map referred to in article 3(2) of the order may be inspected at the offices of the district council. Prints may be purchased from the Department of the Environment's Map Library.

Incidental, consequential, transitional and supplementary provision in consequence of orders of the nature of the present one is contained in the Regulations referred to in article 2 of the order.
