# LOCAL GOVERNMENT, ENGLAND AND WALES CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

## The Macclesfield and Vale Royal (Areas) Order 1982

Made - - - - 6th December 1982
Laid before Parliament 17th December 1982

Whereas the Local Government Boundary Commission for England, under sections 47 and 51(1) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), on 2nd July 1981, made proposals to the Secretary of State for the Environment for the transfer of part of the District of Vale Royal to the Borough of Macclesfield:

Now therefore the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) of the said Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order giving effect to the said proposals with a modification:—

#### Title and commencement

- 1. This order may be cited as the Macclesfield and Vale Royal (Areas) Order 1982.
- 2. 1st March 1983 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purposes set out in regulation 4(1) (Coming into operation of order) of the Regulations.

For all other purposes this order shall come into operation on the appointed day.

## Interpretation

3. In this order-

"the appointed day" means 1st April 1983;

"the boundary map" means the map printed for Her Majesty's Stationery Office by Ordnance Survey as "Map referred to in the Macclesfield and Vale Royal (Areas) Order 1982", the sheets of the said map being respectively marked 1 and 2; and

"the Regulations" means the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(a) as amended by the Local Government Area Changes (Amendment) Regulations 1978(b).

#### Changes in areas

4. That part of the District of Vale Royal and of the Parish of Antrobus which is shown coloured red on the boundary map shall be transferred to the Borough of Macclesfield and to the Parish of Aston by Budworth and shall form part of the Bucklow electoral division of the County of Cheshire, of the High Legh ward of the Borough of Macclesfield, of the Macclesfield petty sessional division and of the East Cheshire coroner's district.

#### Town and country planning

5. The provisions applicable to the area transferred by article 4 of any local plan which has been adopted by the District Council of Vale Royal shall have effect as if they were a local plan adopted by the Borough Council of Macclesfield.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order transfers part of the District of Vale Royal (and of the Parish of Antrobus) to the Borough of Macclesfield (and the Parish of Aston by Budworth). The part transferred has approximately an area of 257 hectares, a population of 60 and a rateable value of £3,400.

The area transferred is shown on the map forming part of this note.

Prints of the map referred to in article 3 of the order may be inspected at the offices of the borough and district councils. Prints may be purchased from the Department of the Environment's Map Library.

Incidental, consequential, transitional and supplementary provision in consequence of orders of the nature of the present one is contained in the Regulations referred to in article 3 of the order.
