

**1982 No. 1802****ROAD TRAFFIC****The Road Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) (Amendment) Regulations 1982**

The Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of the power conferred by section 37 of the Vehicles (Excise) Act 1971(a), as extended by section 12 of the Finance Act 1976(b), and of all other enabling powers, and with the approval of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 10th January 1983, and may be cited as the Road Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) (Amendment) Regulations 1982.

2. The Road Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) Regulations 1971(c) are further amended so that in Regulation 9 (Assignment of registration marks), in paragraph (4A), for “£50” there is substituted “£80”.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations further amend the Road Vehicles (Registration and Licensing) Regulations 1971 by raising from £50 to £80 the fee for the assignment of a registration mark where at the request of the owner of a vehicle a particular registration mark is to be assigned to it, having previously been assigned to another vehicle.
